Day 1 Munich

Highlights: Introduction to Bavarian culture!

- Arrival in Munich
- City orientation through the Bavarian capital Munich, see important sights, monuments and the beautiful Old Town (excl. entrances)
- Welcome Dinner in a typical Bavarian restaurant
- Overnight in Munich



Day 2 Munich

Highlights: Paths of technology and Automotive industries!

- Morning Deutsches Museum largest museum of technology and science –during an exploratory visit you learn about what does the surface of the Moon look like and how many stars are in the sky? Follow the path of discovery to learn about the mp3 player, aspirin and the microscope and the people that have invented them +
- Afternoon Visit the BMW plant and get a direct insight into the state-of-the-art automobile manufacture. See the plant AND the recycling and dismantling centre during two guided visits ++
- <u>Alternative:</u> Wildlife reserve on a farm just outside of Munich see deer, goats, pigs and other farm animals close-up ++
- Overnight in Munich



Day 3 Freiburg

Highlights: Explore the beautiful Black Forest!

- Departure to Freiburg region (340 km, approx. 5hrs at 70km/h)
- Afternoon –It's extraordinary for the Southern Black Forest, that
 nature and many types of human land use (such as farming,
 forestry and tourism) can co-exist here. Take a guided hike
 through the nature park by a trained ranger who can explain you
 about the different types of trees and animals of the region + + +
- Overnight in Freiburg region



Day 4 Winterthur / Zurich

Highlights: Investigate the crime scene during a forensics workshop!

- Departure to Winterthur
- Visit technorama in Winterthur and learn more about DNA during a forensics workshop – learn how criminal professionals detect evidence +
- Continue to Zurich (150 km, approx. 2 hrs at 70km/h)
- Overnight in Zurich

Highlights: Molecular Biology in your hands!

- Morning City orientation led by local students let them show you around their home town and hear their secret tips in town ++ (excl. entrances)
- Afternoon Full-hands on workshop on Molecular Biology at a Science Center of the renowned ETH university in Zurich +
- Overnight in Zurich



Day 6 Interlaken/Grindelwald region

Highlights: Stunning views from the Swiss Alps!

- Departure to Interlaken/Grindelwald region (50 km, approx. 1 hr at 70km/h)
- Morning Enjoy an easy hike in the Swiss Alps to see some of the world's most exciting waterfalls ++
- Continue to Geneva (220km, approx. 3 hrs at 70km/h)
- Overnight in Geneva



Day 7 Geneva

Highlights: International relations and Nuclear Research!

- Morning visit CERN, the European Organisation for Nuclear Research that focuses on fundamental physics. Enjoy a guided tour by one of the staff that comprises an introductory film as well as visits to the experimental areas and one of the accelerators +
- Afternoon the second highlight of day leads you to the diplomatic heart of Europe – during a visit to the United Nations headquarters. Speak to a member of the staff about the organisation and its work worldwide ++
- Farewell dinner
- Overnight in Geneva
